2-year term January 1, 2020—December 31, 2021

- Arkansas State Treasurer Peggy Bundy will mail Nominating Forms to the President of each Arkansas Chapter. If there is a nominee from the chapter, the form must be returned to Peggy Bundy no later than November 30, 2018.
- An Acceptance Form will be mailed to each nominee to be returned to the AR State
 Treasurer by December 31, 2018. Signing of this form by a Nominee certifies that the
 Nominee accepts the nomination and, if elected, is capable of performing the duties of
 AR State Director for the 2-year term.
- The AR State Treasurer will collect the information received by the deadline and will send a ballot to each AR chapter January 1, 2019.
- Ballots are to be returned to the AR State Treasurer by February 28, 2019.
- Elected Nominee will be notified by Peggy Bundy of the result of the Election and the AR State Good Sam membership will be notified at the AR State Committee Meeting on Saturday, April 13, 2019.


